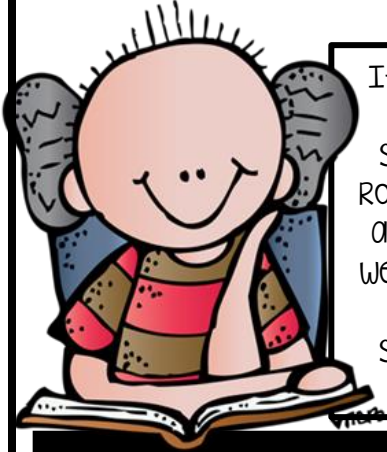


September 12th – 16th News
